DIRECT DEBIT

Do to the costs involved where tenants pay their rent by cheque, the committee are considering introducing a surcharge. It currently costs Anchor Tenants £33.28 per year to collect from a tenant that pays by cheque every week. Direct debit costs are £5.40 per tenant per year. The Management Committee ask that everyone considers carefully paying by direct debit. A form can be obtained from the office.
